


## How to Search the Funding Opportunities List Using the Keyword/Disciplines

The “Keywords/Discipline” column is intended to help narrow down the search for funding opportunities that may relate to your area of research. While the categories are broad, excluding certain keywords may help shorten the list of potential funding opportunities to read through in more detail. It is possible to return to the default full list of all funding opportunities at any time.

Please be sure to include “Any discipline” and “Unclassified/Other” in all searches.

### 1. Select the “Keywords/Discipline” box



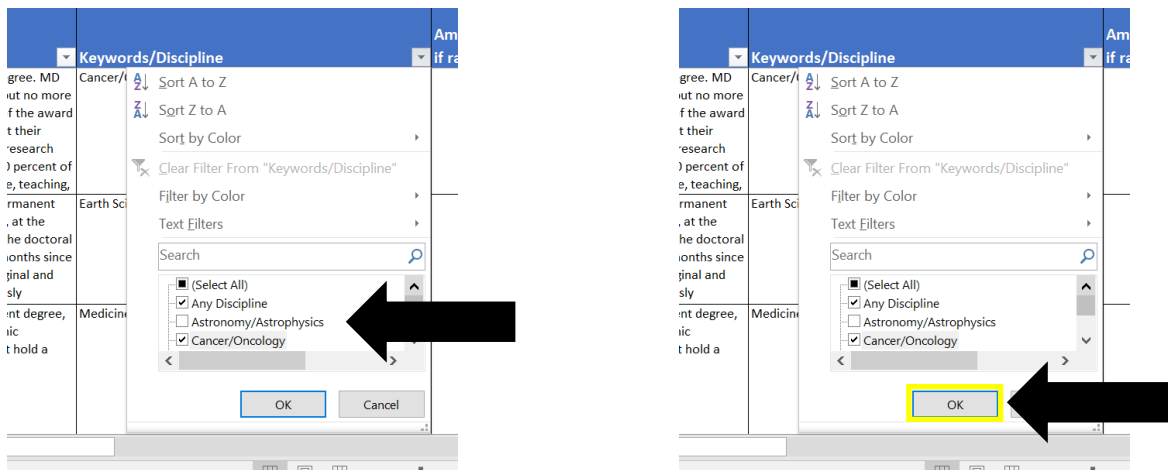

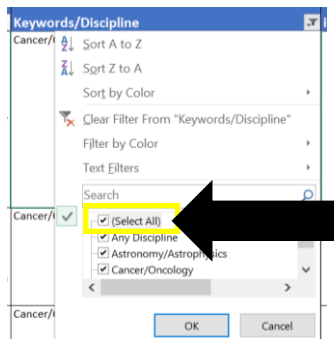

Conquer Cancer Foundation	<a href="#">Young Investigator Award</a>	The Young Investigator Award (YIA) provides funding to promising investigators to encourage and promote quality research in clinical oncology. The purpose of this grant is to fund physicians during the transition from a fellowship program to a faculty appointment.	Applicants must meet the following criteria to qualify for a YIA: • Be a physician (MD, DO, or international equivalent) working in any country and currently in the last two years of his/her final subspecialty training at an academic medical institution and within 10 years of obtaining his/her medical degree at the time of grant submission. Examples of subspecialty training include, but are not limited to, a hematology-oncology fellowship, a surgical oncology fellowship, or a radiation oncology residency.
